Travel Instructions Intl. Geo Bee / Intl. History Olympiad

Nikolassee → *Deutsches Historisches Museum* (German History Museum)

Begin: At the S-bahn Station Nikolassee

Board the S1 (direction Oranienburg or Frohnau).

Get off after 16 stops at *Friedrichstraße*, follow signs for the *Ausgang Friedrichstraße*; go up the stairs one level. You should be standing next to a Dunkin Donuts[™]. Continue through the entire station (passing in between shops like EDEKA[™] and Burger King[™]) until you reach the end of the station (standing between Clarks[™] and Vitalia[™]).

Exit the Station down short steps and turn right onto *Friedrichstraße*; you should pass a McDonalds™ on your right first.

Continue down the *Friedrichstraß*e until you reach the 4^{th} intersection (there is a Douglas^m on the left at this corner).

This is a parkway meaning both lanes are divided, it is called *Unter den Linden*. Do not cross remaining on this side.

Turn left onto *Unter den Linden* and continue down it (you should be heading toward the TV Tower NOT the Brandenburg Gate).

After 450 meters you will see a Prussian-pink building with posters featuring historical artifacts. This is history museum. It is the last building before crossing the river.

End: German History Museum (*Deutsches Historisches Museum*) Unter den Linden 2, 10117 Berlin

German History Museum (*Deutsches Historisches Museum*) → Berlin Brandenburg International School (Zehlendorf)

Begin: German History Museum (Deutsches Historisches Museum)

Exit the museum using the front exit; turn right onto *Unter den Linden*. Continue down *Unter den Linden* for 450+ meters then take the 4th right onto *Friedrichstraße*.

At the End of the street you will see a large overpass that has the words, *DB-Bahnhof Friedrichstraße-S* on it, head towards this.

Continue down *Friedrichstraße* until you reach the Station itself (at the McDonalds $^{\text{\tiny M}}$).

Enter the station and walk through the length of it, passing in between shops like EDEKA™ and Burger King™) looking for signs for the 11-12. The entrance for the S1 is a set of stairs leading down on the far end of the station on the right side, next to Dunkin Donuts™, walk down these stairs.

Board the S1 (direction Wannsee. or Zehlendorf).

Get off after 13 stops at Zehlendorf.

End: At the S-bahn Station Zehlendorf

Nikolassee → Friedrichstraße

Begin: At the S-bahn Station Nikolassee

Board the S1 (direction Oranienburg or Frohnau).

Get off after 16 stops at *Friedrichstraße*, follow signs for the *Ausgang Friedrichstraße*, go up the stairs one level. You should be standing next to a Dunkin Donuts^{TM}.

End: At the S-bahn Station Friedrichstraße

Friedrichstraße → BBIS (Zehlendorf)

Begin: At the S-bahn Station Nikolassee

Follow signs for the S1, the S2, and the S25. The platform where they leave from is down the stairs next to Dunkin Donuts $^{\text{TM}}$.

Board the S1 (direction Wannsee. or Zehlendorf).

Get off after 13 stops at Zehlendorf.

End: At the S-bahn Station *Zehlendorf*

Friedrichstraße → Neues Museum

Begin: At the S-bahn Station Nikolassee

Board the S1 (direction Oranienburg or Frohnau).

Get off after 16 stops at Friedrichstraße, follow signs for the Ausgang

Friedrichstraße; go up the stairs one level. You should be standing next to a Dunkin Donuts™. Continue through the entire station (passing in between shops like EDEKA™ and Burger King™) until you reach the end of the station (standing between Clarks™ and Vitalia™).

Exit the Station down short steps and turn right onto *Friedrichstraße*; you should pass a McDonalds™ on your right first.

Continue down the *Friedrichstraß*e until you reach the 4^{th} intersection (there is a DouglasTM on the left at this corner).

This is a parkway meaning both lanes are divided, it is called *Unter den Linden*. Do not cross remaining on this side.

Turn left onto *Unter den Linden* and continue down it (you should be heading toward the TV Tower NOT the Brandenburg Gate).

After 450± meters you will see a Prussian-pink building with posters featuring historical artifacts just before you reach the river. Walk past the History Museum and cross the river. Immediately turn left and walk along the riverbank. Take the first right (behind the large marble building, the *Altes Museum*).

The old building that is facing you (immediately across the street) is the *Neues Museum*. The main entrance is on the right side of the building.

End: Neues Museum, Bodestraße 1-3, 10178 Berlin

Friedrichstraße → Zoo

Begin: At the S-bahn Station Friedrichstraße

Follow signs for the S3, the S5, the S7, and the S9. (Upstairs)

Board the S3 (direction Board the S3 (direction Spandau), the S5 (direction

Westkreuz), the S7 (direction Potsdam Hbf), or the S9 (Direction Spandau).

Get off after 4 stops at Zoologischer Garten Berlin.

Descend the stairs and take the hallway toward the mural with elephants and bears. Turn right at the mural exit the station on the side with Spar Express™ towards the large parking lot filled with taxis and buses. On the wall of the building facing you there should be a large sign with a giraffe on it.

Cross this parking lot to the sign with the giraffe, continue the way it is pointing (left) for 150+ meters. Enter the zoo by turning right.

End: Berlin Zoo (Zoologischer Garden Berlin), Hardenbergplatz 8, 10787 Berlin

Friedrichstraße → Jewish Museum (Jüdisches Museum Berlin), Begin: At the S-bahn Station Friedrichstraße

Follow signs for the U6. You need to go through the entire length of the station and even cross the *Friedrichstraße* to the other half of the station to get to the U-bahn station.

Go down the stairs to the U-bahn platform.

Board the U6 (direction Alt-Mariendorf).

Get off after 3 stops at Kochstraße.

Follow signs for the *Ausgang Friedrichstraße*; avoid those for Checkpoint Charlie.

You should exit in the middle of the street, cross to be on the left side (on which there is the beautiful façade of the Hotel Angleterre.

Go down Friedrichstraße for about 500 meters until you reach the second left.

Take the second left (between the glass building and the cellphone store) onto a side street (merely called the crosswalk).

Continue down this street until it ends as it hits the *Lindenstraße*.

Cross the *Lindenstraße*.

You are now standing in front of a grey building with walls that seem to be missing chunks. This is the Jewish Museum of Berlin.

End: Jewish Museum Berlin (*Jüdisches Museum Berlin*), Lindenstraße 9-14, 10969 Berlin

Friedrichstraße → DDR Museum

Begin: At the S-bahn Station Friedrichstraße

Board the S1 (direction Oranienburg or Frohnau).

Get off after 16 stops at Friedrichstraße, follow signs for the Ausgang

Friedrichstraße; go up the stairs one level. You should be standing next to a Dunkin Donuts™. Continue through the entire station (passing in between shops like EDEKA™ and Burger King™) until you reach the end of the station (standing between Clarks™ and Vitalia™).

Exit the Station down short steps and turn right onto Friedrichstraße; you should pass a McDonalds^M on your right first.

Continue down the *Friedrichstraß*e until you reach the 4^{th} intersection (there is a Douglas^m on the left at this corner).

This is a parkway meaning both lanes are divided, it is called *Unter den Linden*. Do not cross remaining on this side.

Turn left onto *Unter den Linden* and continue down it (you should be heading toward the TV Tower NOT the Brandenburg Gate).

After 450± meters you will see a Prussian-pink building with posters featuring historical artifacts just before you reach the river. Walk past the History Museum and cross the river. Continue for 300± meters as you traverse the island (passing by the *Berliner Dom*) and cross the river again.

As soon as you reach the riverbank, turn left. You can descend the stairs down to the waterfront. This is where the entrance to the GDR (DDR) Museum is.

End: GDR Museum (DDR Museum)

A&O Hostel → **German History Museum**

Begin: S-bahn Station Ostbahnhof

Board the S3 (direction Erkner), the S5 (direction Strausberg Nord), the S7 (direction Ahrensfelde), the S9 (direction Flughafen SXF).

Get off after 4 stops at *Friedrichstraße*, follow signs for the *Ausgang Friedrichstraße*; go down the stairs to ground level. Continue through the entire station (passing in between shops like EDEKATM and Burger KingTM) until you reach the end of the station (standing between ClarksTM and VitaliaTM).

Exit the Station and turn right onto *Friedrichstraße*; you should pass a McDonalds™ first.

Continue down the *Friedrichstraß*e until you reach the 5^{th} intersection (there is a DouglasTM at this corner).

This is a parkway meaning both lanes are divided, it is called *Unter den Linden*. Remain on this side.

Turn left onto *Unter den Linden* and continue down it (you should be heading toward the TV Tower NOT the Brandenburg Gate).

After 400 meters you will see a Prussian-pink building with posters featuring historical artifacts. This is history museum. It is **the last building before crossing the river.**

End: German History Museum (*Deutsches Historisches Museum*) Unter den Linden 2, 10117 Berlin

Berlin Brandenburg International School \rightarrow GDR Museum (*DDR Museum*) \rightarrow Spy Museum

Begin: At the S-bahn Station Nikolassee

Board the S1 (direction Oranienburg or Frohnau).

Get off after 16 stops at *Friedrichstraße*, follow signs for the *Ausgang Friedrichstraße*; go up the stairs one level. You should be standing next to a Dunkin Donuts™. Continue through the entire station (passing in between shops like

EDEKA[™] and Burger King[™]) until you reach the end of the station (standing between Clarks[™] and Vitalia[™]).

Exit the Station and turn right onto *Friedrichstraße*; you should pass a McDonalds™ first.

Continue down the *Friedrichstraß*e until you reach the 5^{th} intersection (there is a DouglasTM at this corner).

This is a parkway meaning both lanes are divided, it is called *Unter den Linden*. Remain on this side.

Turn left onto *Unter den Linden* and continue down it (you should be heading toward the TV Tower NOT the Brandenburg Gate).

After 400 meters you will pass the History Museum and reach the river. Cross the river and continue for 150 meters as you traverse the island (passing by the *Berliner Dom*) and cross the river again.

As soon as you reach the riverbank, turn left. You can descend the stairs down to the waterfront. This is where the entrance to the GDR Museum is.

Stop: GDR Museum (*DDR Museum*), Karl-Liebknecht-Str. 1, 10178 Berlin Exit the Museum, and climb the stairs so as to return to the large street, which is called *Karl-Liebknecht-Straße* on this side of the river.

Turn right onto the street (you should have the river in front of you and the TV Tower at your back).

Cross the river and walk by the Berliner Dom.

On your side of the street there should be a bus stop, marked by a pole with a large "H" sign mounted on it, it is called *Lustgarten*.

Board the 200 Bus (direction S+U Zoologischer Garten via Potsdamer Platz).

Get off after 11 stops at S+U Potsdamer Platz.

You will be standing in the middle of a plaza surrounded by buildings. Stay on this side of the plaza.

Cross the green area to the buildings. Next to the Salvador Dali Gallery you will see the Spy Museum. The windows are outlined in green.

End: Spy Museum, Leipziger Pl. 9, 10117 Berlin

BBIS → Jewish Museum → German Museum of Technology Begin: At the S-bahn Station Nikolassee

Board the S1 (direction Oranienburg or Frohnau).

Get off after 13 stops at *Anhalter Bahnhof*, follow signs for the *Ausgang Anhalter Bahnhof*, *Stressemanstraße*, *Askanischer Platz*. Ideally you should be at the corner of the *Stressemanstraße and Schöneberger Straße*.

Turn right to go down the *Stressemanstraße*. You should be on the side of the street with the old façade of the station and it should be on your right as you go down the street.

Continue down the *Stressemanstraße* for about 200 meters until you see the first street on the left side. Cross over and onto the *Hedemannstraße* (you will see a line of trash containers for disposing of glass at the entrance to the street.)

Go down the *Hedemannstraße* for 200 meters until you reach the *Wilhelmstraße*. Cross and turn right onto the *Wilhelmstraße*.

Go down the *Wilhelmstraße* and take the first left to go under the large triangular arch. Go through the courtyard and the arch on the far end and cross the *Friedrichstraße*.

Turn right, walk about 25 meters and immediately turn left (between the glass building and the cellphone store) onto a side street (merely called the crosswalk). Continue down this street until it ends as it hits the *Lindenstraße*.

Cross the *Lindenstraße*.

You are now standing in front of a grey building with walls that seem to be missing chunks. This is the Jewish Museum of Berlin.

Stop: Jewish Museum Berlin (*Jüdisches Museum Berlin*), Lindenstraße 9-14, 10969 Berlin

Exit the Jewish Museum onto the *Lindenstraße*.

Turn left onto *Lindenstraße*. Continue down it for about 500 meters until you reach the water. Cross the bridge to the other side, immediately turn right.

Walk along the river for 700 meters until you facing a large building with a plane on the roof. This is the technical museum.

End: German Museum of Technology Trebbiner Str. 9, 10963 Berlin

A&O Hostel → Friedrichstraße

Begin: S-bahn Station Ostbahnhof

Board the S3 (direction Erkner), the S5 (direction Strausberg Nord), the S7 (direction Ahrensfelde), the S9 (direction Flughafen SXF).

Get off after 4 stops at *Friedrichstraße*.

Go down the stairs to get to ground level.

End: At the S-bahn Station Friedrichstraße.

$A\&O Hostel \rightarrow Hotel Adlon \rightarrow A\&O Hostel$

Begin: Ostbahnhof S-bahn Station

Board the S3 (direction Spandau), the S5 (direction Westkreuz), the S7 (direction Potsdam Hbf), or the S9 (direction Spandau).

Get off after 4 stops at Friedrichstraße.

Follow signs for the S1, the S2, and the S25. The platform where they leave from is down the stairs next to Dunkin Donuts $^{\text{TM}}$.

Board the S1 (direction *Wannsee*. or *Zehlendorf*), the S2 (direction Blankenfelde), or the S25 (direction Teltower Stadt)

Get off after 1 stop at *Brandenburger Tor*.

Follow signs for the "Ausgang Brandenburger Tor".

Climb the steps and you should see the Brandenburg Gate, turn left and you will be facing the Hotel Adlon, cross the street and enter the building.

Stop: Hotel Adlon Unter den Linden 77

Exit the Hotel Adlon.

Cross the street, go down the stairs and enter the S-bahn station, *Brandenburger Tor*. Follow signs for the S1, the S2, and the S25.

Board the S1 (direction Oranienburg or Frohnau), or the S2 (direction Bernau).

Get off after 1 stop at Friedrichstraße.

Climb the stairs, following signs for the S3, S5, S7, S9.

Board the S3 (direction Erkner), the S5 (direction Strausberg Nord), the S7

(direction Ahrensfelde), and the S9 (direction Flughafen SXF). Get off after 4 stops at Ostbahnhof.

A&O Hostel → Berlin Brandenburg International School (Zehlendorf)

Begin: Ostbahnhof S-bahn Station

Board the S3 (direction Erkner), the S5 (direction Strausberg Nord), the S7 (direction Ahrensfelde), the S9 (direction Flughafen SXF).

Get off after 4 stops at Friedrichstraße.

Follow signs for the S1, the S2, and the S25. The platform where they leave from is down the stairs next to Dunkin Donuts $^{\text{TM}}$.

Board the S1 (direction Wannsee. or Zehlendorf).

Get off after 13 stops at Zehlendorf.

End: S-bahn Station Zehlendorf

Ostbahnhof → Natural History Museum (*Museum für Naturkunde*) Begin: Ostbahnhof S-bahn Station

Board the S3 (direction Erkner), the S5 (direction Strausberg Nord), the S7 (direction Ahrensfelde), the S9 (direction Flughafen SXF).

Get off after 4 stops at *Friedrichstraße*.

Go down the stairs to ground level.

Follow signs for the U6. You need to go through the entire length of the station and even cross the *Friedrichstraße* to the other half of the station to get to the U-bahn station.

Go down the stairs to the U-bahn platform.

Board the U6 (direction *Alt-Tegel*).

Get off after 3 stops at Naturkundemuseum.

Follow signs for the "Ausgang Invalidenstraße/Naturkundemuseum".

Climb the stairs. You should be standing next to an eatery named: Relax Food & You™.

Continue down the street the way you are facing (with Relax Food & You™ at your right) for about 50 meters. You should be standing in front of the Natural History Museum.

End: Natural History Museum (*Museum für Naturkunde*) Invalidenstraße 43, 10115 Berlin
